




GHENT UNIVERSITY GLOBAL CAMPUS

In September 2014, Ghent University was invited to join Incheon Global Campus (Songdo International Business District, Incheon) through an international development project by the Korean Ministry of Trade Industry and Energy, the Korean Ministry of Education, and Incheon Free Economic Zone.

As the Ghent University is the first European university established in South Korea, the extended campus ("Ghent University Global Campus") offers the same bachelor's degrees as students on the home campus, Ghent, Belgium.

BACHELOR PROGRAMMES

All courses at the Ghent University Global Campus(GUGC) are designed to offer European bachelor's degrees to students who wish to study abroad with the opportunity to develop a solid global foundation in Korea. Thus, the GUGC became a central hub to attract students from Asian countries while additionally creating international partnerships with its home campus, Ghent, Belgium.

Environmental Technology, ET


Food Technology, FT



Admission Types and Requirements

For applicants who hold an international or international school diploma.
