


Under our credo 'Dare to Think,' we are training tomorrow's leaders to continue the progress of humanity through new thinking and constant innovation.






GHENT UNIVERSITY GLOBAL CAMPUS

In September 2014, Ghent University was invited to join Incheon Global Campus (Songdo International Business District, Incheon) through an international development project by the Korean Ministry of Trade Industry and Energy, the Korean Ministry of Education, and Incheon Free Economic Zone. As the Ghent University is the first European university established in South Korea, the extended campus (“Ghent University Global Campus”) offers the same bachelor’s degrees as students on the home campus, Ghent, Belgium.

Overview



BACHELOR PROGRAMMES

All courses at the Ghent University Global Campus (GUGC) are designed to offer European bachelor's degrees to students who wish to study abroad with the opportunity to develop a solid global foundation in Korea. Thus, the GUGC became a central hub to attract students from Asian countries while additionally creating international partnerships with its home campus, Ghent, Belgium.

Environmental Technology, ET

The Department of Environmental Technology cultivates environmental experts with abundant knowledge and expertise in environmental problems and ecological science concepts such as the circulation processes of water, air, and soil.


Food Technology, FT



For applicants who hold an international or international school diploma.

Tuition Fees

Basic Fixed Fee: KRW 2,000,000 (No deferred payment or refund)
Undergraduate Tuition: KRW 18,000,000 (KRW 300,000 per credit, based on 60 required credits per year)
Dormitory: KRW 3,600,000 for single room, KRW 2,400,000 for a double room, and KRW 1,920,000 for a triple room (based on 32 weeks of residence during the semester)
